I am a RACCOON



I am *semiaquatic*, meaning I live on both land and in the water. My silky brown fur has two layers: a waterproof outer coat and a soft, fine layer beneath to keep me warm in cold rivers and lakes. I like to eat fish, frogs, turtles, and other water animals.

I am a **RIVER OTTER**



My fur changes color and thickness throughout the year, getting warmer and paler in the winter, lighter and darker in the summer. I use my big ears to listen for danger and hide from predators in my nest or burrow. I am an *herbivore*, so I only eat plants, like grass, fruit, or tree leaves.

I am a **RABBIT**



My soft fur is usually brown, black, or gray, with stripes or spots all across my body. I live in lots of different *biomes*, from forests to swamps to deserts. I'm a hunter, with deadly claws and sharp teeth to catch my prey.

I am a **BOBCAT**



I have red fur on my back, white fur on my belly, and a little black fur on my ears, legs, and feet. I'll eat just about anything, including small animals, fruits, and grasses. I do most of my hunting and scavenging at dusk and dawn.

I am a **RED FOX**



My fur is gray, black, and white, the color of salt and pepper. I'm smaller than my red-furred cousin, with a stiffer and coarser coat. But like my cousin, I'm an *omnivore*, eating whatever I can find, from insects to rabbits to vegetables.

I am a **GRAY FOX**



My glossy coat is some of the softest fur you can find in the animal kingdom. I live near rivers, lakes, and marshes. I like to catch fish, but I'll also eat birds, eggs, and small animals like rabbits.

I am a **MINK**
